

# Build a Bird

5 & Up

Create your own bird. Think about where your bird would live (its habitat) and what it might eat. Choose body parts that will help your bird find food and survive in its habitat. What colour will your bird be? Will it blend in (camouflage), or be boldly coloured? Colour and cut out the various bird parts below (2 pages). Lay the parts out to see what your bird looks like - mix them up, get creative.

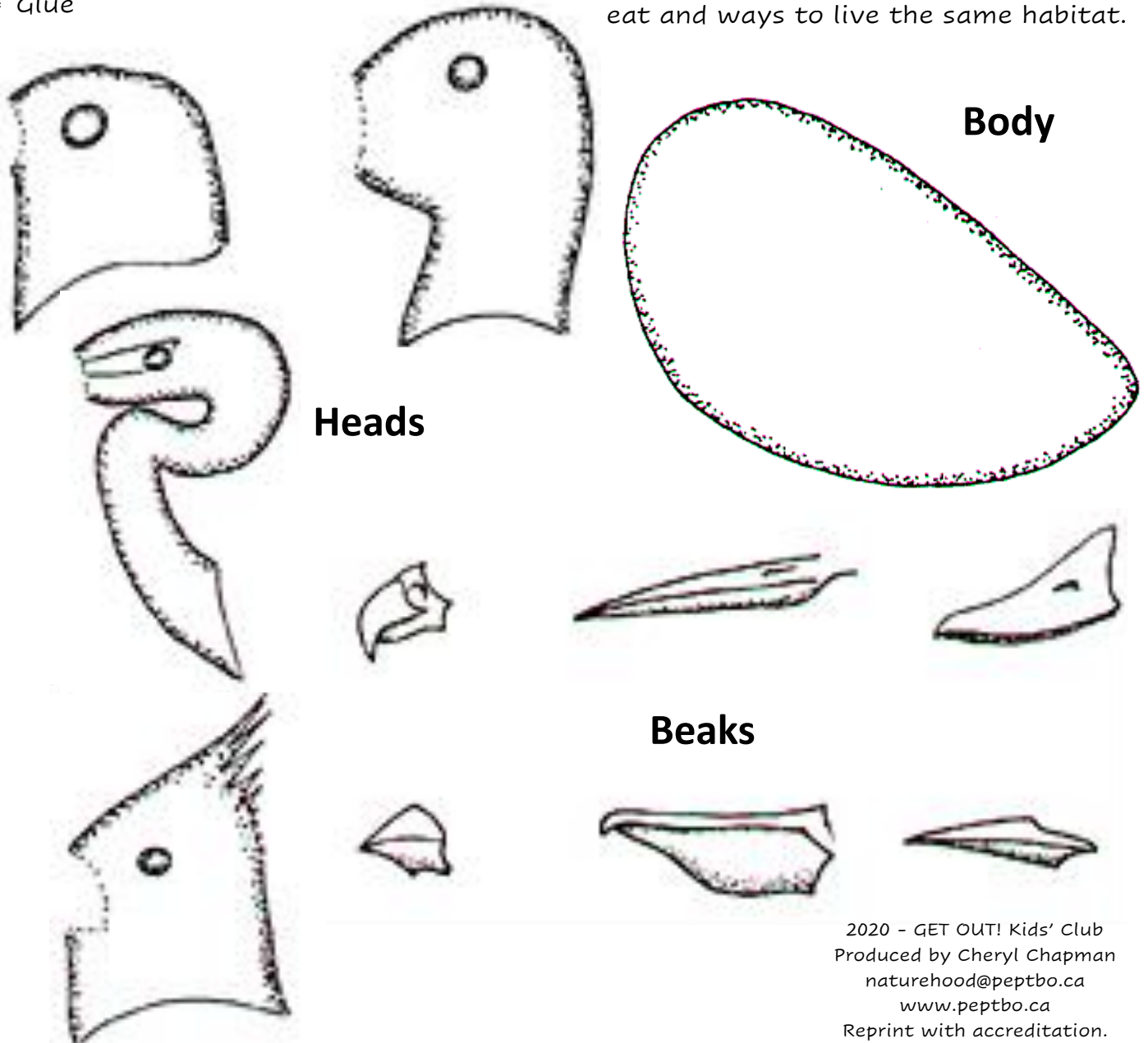
## Supplies:

- \* Glue

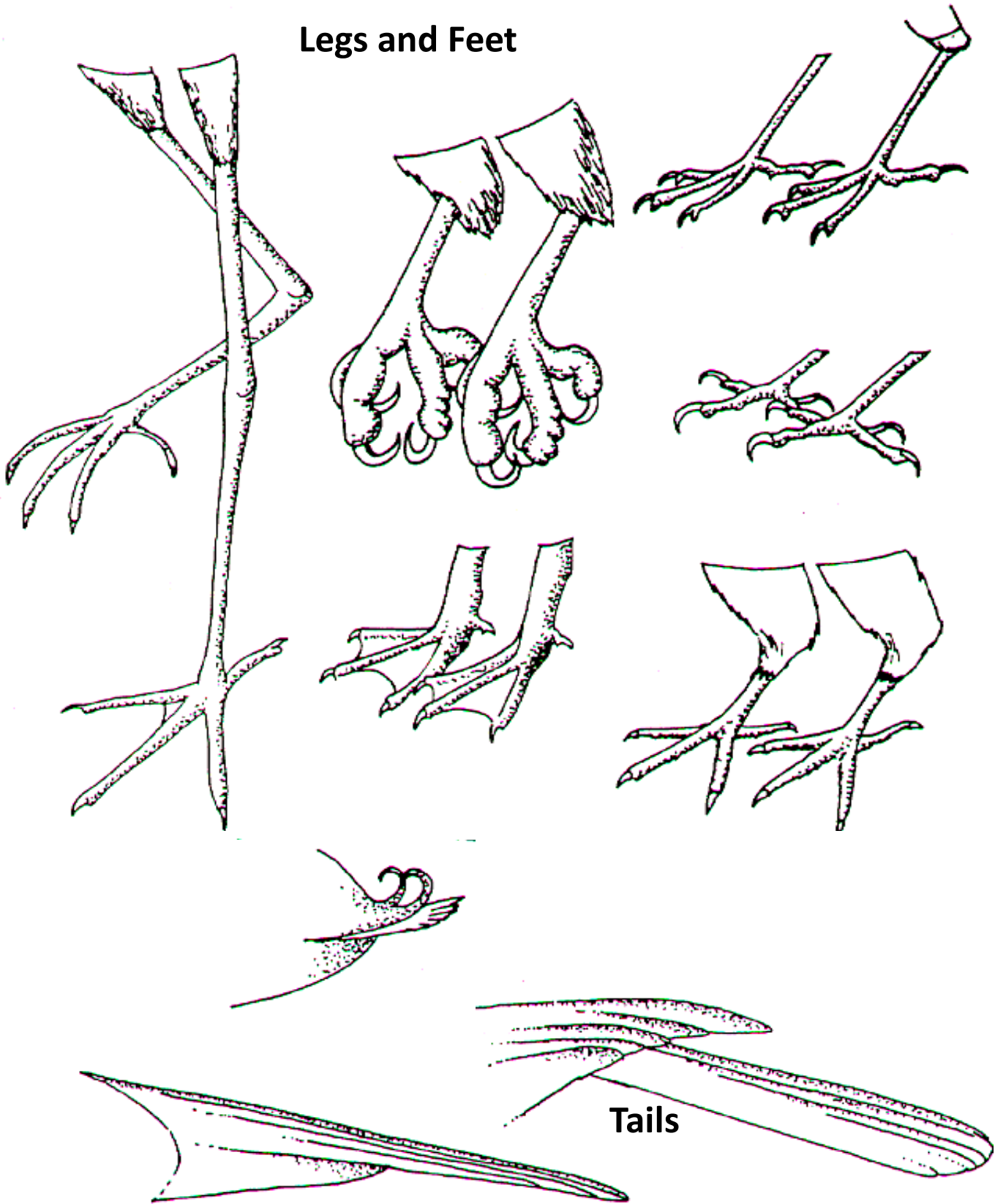
On a blank piece of paper draw your bird's habitat; a pond, a garden, a forest or perhaps an imaginary place.
